Welcome back to school for our final term of this year. There is a lot going on!

Term Four Date Changes

We have reviewed our need for two Teacher Only Days, and will now have one, on Monday 20^{th} November. We are therefore able to shorten our term by one day, therefore the last day of school will be Monday 18^{th} December.

Four Teachers in 2024

We were recently informed that due to our high roll numbers, we will be funded for a fourth teacher for 2024. We are currently advertising to try to fill this position. I expect this to be a temporary situation, for 2024 only, as we will be better able to control our roll once the Enrolment Zone is in place at the beginning of next year. I am currently working out how to house four classes within our buildings and will let you know more once I have worked out this dilemma.

Students are requested to make a **minimum of two** and a **maximum of four** individual activities.

A GIFT

♦ A gift for a grandparent.

COOKING

- ♦ Baking decorated like an animal or in a spring theme.
- Homemade sweets & other baking GROWING
- ♦ A growing container garden, e.g., tub of vegetables, hanging basket etc
- ♦ A decorative sand saucer or miniature garden

CONSTRUCTING

These two activities may be a group or an individual activity:

- ♦ A Lego creation- in either a spring theme or pet theme
- ♦ A large boat or raft judging criteria: that will support at least one person and can paddle the length of the school pool
- ◆ A small boat or raft-judging criteria: that it will stay afloat while all of the large boats or rafts are paddling the length of the pool, and it has a lot of detail on it.

These are all to be **prepared at home**.

Creations must be made by the students, NOT the parents and not store bought.

We will also have a table for pre-schoolers' entries.

Please **do not** name your work; we will give you stickers with your special anonymous code on it.

Students will be doing additional activities at school.
